Chaperone Instructions: Have students read the introduction and clues. Help them decipher each clue and write down the name of the animal on the dashed lines (use the number of dashes to help you). Travel to the animal habitats, read the ID signs, and write down what each animal likes to eat. Then, use the numbered letters to answer a riddle on the back!

Use a ZooTampa map to help you navigate through the Zoo and find the animals you are looking for. Animals are found in different realms in the Zoo based on their natural habitats, and their names are listed on the map. You can explore the Zoo however you choose, but the clues are in order (first-last or last-first) to make a path around the Zoo.
